Klyde Warren Park will celebrate the opening of the new Nancy Best Fountain, an incredibly unique, interactive water feature soon to become an iconic Dallas landmark.

Dallas children from nearby schools will be the first to enjoy the 5,000-square foot water feature, as they play within the glowing streams of recycled water, marking the Fountain's formal introduction to the North Texas community.

The Fountain features a 5,000-square foot splash pad able to accommodate hundreds of children at a time. In the evening, the Fountain will come alive with dancing waters and a choreographed light and music show, which will change monthly. Guests are encouraged to play in the water during the show, making it one of the most unique fountains in the country.
