Frisco, Texas (November 21, 2022) — The PGA of America is in the holiday spirit, announcing today that Championship Grounds Ticket Packages for the [2023 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship](#) will be sold at a special holiday offer of 10% off until Dec. 31, 2022. The 2023 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship will be the first Major Championship to be played at PGA Frisco, the new home of the [PGA of America](#) and [Omni PGA Frisco Resort](#).

The KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship, the most historic and prestigious Major Championship in senior golf, will be contested May 24-28, 2023, on Fields Ranch East at PGA Frisco. The Championship will bring the most accomplished golfers in the world over the age of 50 to the area, including 2022 Senior PGA Champion, Steven Alker.

For the next six weeks, the Championship-long Grounds Ticket Package will be sold at a 10% savings during a special holiday offer. The Championship-long ticket package starts at \$205.

“We’re excited to share this special holiday offer, and all of us at the PGA of America look forward to welcoming spectators to the first Major Championship contested here at PGA Frisco next May.” said Jason Mengel, Championship Director of the 83rd KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship.

Daily grounds ticket prices for the 2023 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship range from \$30 for Wednesday’s practice round, \$45 for the first round on Thursday, \$50 for Friday’s second round, and \$55 for the final two rounds over the weekend. All grounds tickets include access to the Championship grounds at PGA Frisco, Championship merchandise shop, water at concessions, and other spectator amenities.

Premium Club tickets begin Thursday of Championship week and will range from \$550 to \$650 for daily club tickets. Club tickets grant access to an open-air entertainment space and an outdoor viewing deck overlooking both the 16th and 17th holes. Club tickets also include a chef-inspired, all-inclusive culinary experience and open bar, executive restrooms, and preferred corporate parking.

The PGA of America will offer complimentary tickets to military members and youth. As part of the PGA of America’s mission to grow the game of golf, children 17 years old and younger will be given free entry into the Championship when accompanied by a ticketed adult.

Military members and one guest will also receive free admission for a one-day pass. This includes Active Duty, Retirees, Veterans, Reserve and National Guard.

Proceeds from the 2023 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship will benefit PGA REACH, the charitable foundation of the PGA of America. PGA REACH aims to positively impact the lives of youth, military, and diverse populations by enabling access to PGA Professionals, PGA Sections, and the game of golf as a whole.

Ticket purchasers, volunteers and corporate hospitality purchasers at the 2023

KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship will receive priority access to offerings at future Championships at PGA Frisco, including the 2027 PGA Championship.

In addition to the KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship, Fields Ranch East at PGA Frisco will be home to an unprecedented cadence of championships, with 26 scheduled over a 13-year span, including two PGA Championships. Future championships to be held at PGA Frisco include the KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship in 2023 and 2029; the KPMG Women's PGA Championship in 2025 and 2031; and the PGA Championship in 2027 and 2034.
