COMPETITION: A number of international PGA TOUR Champions stars are set to tee it up at this year's Invited Celebrity Classic, including Vijay Singh, Colin Montgomerie and Retief Goosen.

A native of Fiji, Singh's hall of fame career resume includes 34 PGA TOUR wins, 22 international victories, and three major championships. He's added four more victories since joining PGA TOUR Champions, including a three-win season in 2018. Singh opened his 2023 PGA TOUR Champions season with a T15 finish at the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai and a T37 in his last start at the Hoag Classic.

The pride of Scotland, Montgomerie accumulated 42 international wins on his way to being inducted into the World Golf Hall of Fame in 2013. The eight-time DP World Tour Order of Merit winner was also a Ryder Cup stalwart for the European team, making eight appearances as a player and captaining the victorious 2010 team. His success has continued on PGA TOUR Champions with seven more wins, three of which were major championships. He'll look to improve on a T21 result at last year's Invited Celebrity Classic.

Goosen hails from South Africa and became a World Golf Hall of Fame member in 2019. Winner of the 2001 and 2004 U.S. Opens, Goosen has amassed seven PGA TOUR victories and 24 international wins during his career. A two-time PGA TOUR Champions winner, Goosen recorded a T15 finish at the Invited Celebrity Classic last year.

The celebrity field is headed by Tony Romo, the former Dallas Cowboys quarterback and prominent NFL TV analyst, active NFL players Adam Thielen and Robbie Gould, Pro Football Hall of Famers Emmitt Smith, Brian Urlacher, Marcus Allen and Tim Brown plus National Baseball Hall of Famers John Smoltz, Greg Maddux and Pudge Rodriguez. Annika Sorenstam, the World Golf Hall of Famer and greatest player in the history of women's golf, is also in the field.

The Invited Celebrity Classic will be an event for fans of all ages. As a company, Invited takes pride in its experiential hospitality from the golf courses to family time.
