With dozens of exhibits and events, combined with extended hours and refreshing air-conditioning, Dallas' iconic science museum sparks the curiosity of guests of all ages. As part of its mission to inspire minds toward a lifelong love of science, the Perot Museum offers a wide range of eye-opening experiences from discovering the unexpected evolution of earth's greatest predator, *Tyrannosaurus rex*, to exploring exhilarating exhibits on every floor, from a mission to Mars to a marble roller coaster ride.

T. rex roams the Perot Museum all summer through September 22, 2024. *T. rex: The Ultimate Predator* exhibit includes the most accurate models and casts of the world's most recognizable dinosaur. The spectacular, interactive multimedia experience provides hands-on activities for an entirely new exploration of the fascinating and fearsome carnivore. A *T. rex* brain cast gauges the powerful hunter's keen sense of hearing, sight and smell. A magical projection demonstrates *T. rex* on the hunt, illustrating the unique physical traits that made the carnivore a noted killing machine. A thrilling sequence in the "shadow theater" illustrates one *T. rex* fiercely fending off another, revealing the injuries and scars left on its bones.

The Perot Museum's Summer of STEM offers opportunities for adults as well. Thursdays on Tap allow adults 21 and over a unique way to experience the Museum after hours, every Thursday night until ten. Each evening event features live music, including Austin native, Bob Schneider on June 13, 2024. Visitors will also enjoy full access to the Museum and all of the exhibit halls, including *T. rex: The Ultimate Predator* on Thursday nights, now through October. A variety of food trucks, refreshing adult beverages including beer, wine, rosé and specialty cocktails are all on offer, along with outdoor games. Thursdays on Tap provides the perfect location for an entertaining date night, or a one-of-a-kind location to meet up with friends or coworkers.

Other summer highlights at the Perot Museum include:

- **Hands-On Activities:** The Bio Lab, CHALLENGE Lab and Art Lab offer come-and-go science experiments for all ages to flex their creative muscles. Engaging challenges range from Marble Roller Coasters to Mini-Dioramas, and Cardboard Arcades to Melodic Music.
- **Fun New Film:** See the monstrous, legendary *T. rex* in jaw-dropping 3D, with immersive surround sound. The new *T. rex* film opens Friday, June 21, 2024.
- **Mission Mars:** Step into the exploration of the red planet in *Mission Mars: Perseverance Rover* running through September 2, 2024.
