

## Children's Cancer Fund Announces \$2.5 Million Gift to Support New Pediatric Campus in Dallas

**DALLAS (March 4, 2026)** – Children's Cancer Fund (CCF) today announced a \$2.5 million donation in support of the new \$5 billion pediatric campus in Dallas, being developed and operated through a partnership between Children's Health<sup>SM</sup> and UT Southwestern Medical Center. The announcement was made today during CCF's annual Model Reveal event at NorthPark Center.

The new Dallas pediatric campus, located directly across from UT Southwestern's William P. Clements Jr. University Hospital, will be one of the largest and most transformative hospital campuses in the country. Named Moody Children's Hospital, the hospital will be designed to meet the growing needs of North Texas and beyond, expanding access to leading-edge treatments, breakthrough research and comprehensive, family-centered care.

CCF's \$2.5 million gift underscores its longstanding commitment to Children's Health and UT Southwestern, and its dedication to advancing pediatric oncology care. In recognition of this investment, a special playroom will serve patients and families receiving care in the Pauline Allen Gill Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders at the new Moody Children's Hospital will bear the CCF name.

"For nearly four decades, Children's Cancer Fund has stood alongside the patients and families served by Children's Health and UT Southwestern," said Jennifer Arthur, Chief Executive Officer of Children's Cancer Fund. "This new pediatric campus represents hope for the future — a place where innovation, compassion and world-class expertise come together under one roof. We are proud to invest in a transformational project that will elevate the standard of care and ensure children in our community have access to the very best treatments close to home."

The new Dallas pediatric campus will significantly enhance the ability of Children's Health and UT Southwestern to deliver integrated, multidisciplinary care — combining clinical excellence with research and education and further positioning North Texas as a national leader in pediatric health care.

"Children's Cancer Fund has long been an extraordinary champion for the patients and families who are served by Children's Health," said Brent Christopher, President of Children's Medical Center Foundation. "This \$2.5 million gift reflects a shared commitment to building a brighter, healthier future for kids. Generous investments like this bring us one step closer to opening a world-class campus that will serve many generations to come."

The new Dallas pediatric campus represents one of the most significant investments in the health of children across the region's history. Once complete, it will strengthen specialized programs, accelerate research discoveries and create a purpose-built environment to meet the unique needs of children and their families.
